PROPERTY/BUILDING & GROUNDS TEAM – Judy Norton, Jerry Brown Dan Cyr will do the interior drywall repair in the two offices, hallway and stairwell going upstairs. His bid is \$950.00. He will repair and texture during the month of January. Judy, Lance & Louis will paint afterwards. Our expense with that is a bucket of paint. He also bid the painting of church exterior, oiling the cedar and also painting the manse for \$11,575.00. We have not finalized that bid as yet, but it is the best estimate we have received. This work would be done in April or May. Judy will break out the Manse cost from the bid. An estimate for electrical work in the Manse is approximately \$15,000.00. Judy will now work on a window replacement estimate for the Manse. There is \$15,000 in the Manse fund.

Repair and updating the Manse will continue. We do have options for financing this project. One option where YOU can help is by donating directly to the Manse Fund. Please specify on your check that the amount is for the Manse.
