REPORTS FROM SESSION MEETING NOVEMBER 9, 2021

PASTOR JANE’S REPORT: During the month of October (31 days), I worked approximately 71.5 hours or approximately 16 hours per week. PROPERTY/BUILDING & GROUNDS TEAM – Judy Norton, Jerry Brown Steel Roofing for the Manse is in except for a few pieces. \$15,100 was donated for the roof. \$10,156.29 is designated for new windows. Roof cost so far is \$11,336.72 which is materials but not labor. The porch roof has been replaced. All new plywood was installed on the roof (cost not included in original quote). The good news is that with extra materials the final cost should be within the budgeted amount!
