<u>Pastor's Report</u> for June: Total hours were 69. Approximately 18.6 hours per week. This included: Service and Sermon Preparation x 3.5 which includes PowerPoints and Bulletins, Sunday School x 3, Session Meeting, Hospital visit, Vacation Bible School, Social time with parishioners. BUILDING & GROUNDS: Jerry Brown & Judy The MANSE progress was studied closely by Session as we are nearing the finish! We are very appreciative of all donations, grants, donated labor by members and the itemized expenses for each part of the contractor's work. Jim and his crew are to be commended for their willingness to work with our specifications and time frame and to remodel with amazing quality workmanship. If you haven't toured the Manse, please do so! The Manse is being offered to ministerial candidates as part of their total salary package. This is brand new interior finish! Housing Rents in the Bayfield area are currently over \$2,000 per month. Including this in a salary package to a minister is a very attractive feature.

Your Session is appealing to our church membership to help finish the Manse. As with any contract building projects, there can be overages due to material price increases, additional labor costs, and/or unforeseen corrections needed. Judy has been documenting each and every expense along with payments but cannot pinpoint an exact amount needed to finish due to the labor costs. We do know we will be short of funds for final pay-off to contractors. Your donation will be much appreciated!

There will be blinds installed in the church office and pastor's study. These will be Duette Ultraglide, Top-down/bottom up Light Filter to in sure privacy, but also to allow light. Session is not ready to order to blinds for the Manse.
