REPORTS FROM SESSION MEETING OCTOBER 19, 2021

**PASTOR JANE’S REPORT:** During the month of September, I prepared sermons for four Sundays.. This also included four Sundays of PowerPoint preparation and Bulletins. There were four actual worship services. I moderated one Session meeting. I attended a Cluster meeting and a Presbytery meeting. Session & I did a Manse walk-through inspection. I took a card to a shut-in. There were discussions with Suzy Meyers (PNC liaison), phone calls and texts with parishioners as well as social time with parishioners. My hours were approximately 60 with an average of 14 per week. I will be away November 10-18. Rev. Emrys Tyler will preach on the 14<sup>th</sup>. Any pastoral needs will be covered by Rev. **PROPERTY/BUILDING & GROUNDS TEAM – Judy Norton, Jerry Brown** Don DeWitt mowed the lawns one last time. Don Wickman turned off the sprinkler system. Jim Sawyer and crew removed the old roofing on the Manse and covered it with weather shield. Steel Roofing will be available in two to three weeks. \$15,100 was donated for the roof. \$10,156.29 is designated for new windows. Roof cost so far is \$11,336.72 which is materials but not labor. The porch roof has been replaced. All new plywood was installed on the roof (cost not included in original quote). The good news is that with extra materials the final cost should be within the budgeted amount!
