Presbytery is granting the church \$23,000.00 which, coupled with monies designated for the Manse will cover modeling the interior. Amen, and amen! Thank Judy, Melanie, Pastor Jane and Carol for their efforts in writing and delivering this application to Presbytery! Our tenants will vacate the Manse by February 1st.

Painting of the church exterior will be done in the spring. MANSE status is moving onward with tenants vacating by February 1st. Plumber is looking at upgrade work this week. Electrical work will be done by Kaylon (K-Power).
